We are always sad to see our older children leave but they are well prepared for their reception year and we wish them well. 120 children are leaving the Nursery this term – that is a lot of reports, assessments and transitions to do!

On Monday we held the annual picnic when all the children in Nursery and Little Harts were able to stay with their families for an hour at lunch time and picnic in the garden. Events like that makes us realize just how many people we see, talk to, hopefully help and work with every day. Since September 2009 these numbers have attended the Centre:

42 children have attended Little Harts
185 children have attended Nursery, 14 of them with severe and complex needs
62 children have attended wraparound care
22 children attended Stay and Play prior to Nursery
29 children attended breakfast club
44 children attended tea club
Approx. 8 families attended Special Harts
Approx. 15 families attended Baby Fun Time
Approx. 80 families attended Mums and Tots.

This is a huge number of individual families and children and the vast majority have been full of praise for our work, and thanks go to them for the kind things they have said and written. Those who wrote suggestions on the annual questionnaires can be assured that we have read them and if we can do something we will.
